On November 15, 2021, a targeted orientation program for newly joined International students of batch 2021-23 was organised in Acharya Chanakya Seminar Hall, GSMS.

The orientation program was designed to introduce the new students to the Graduate School of Management Studies and the MBA (International Business) programme to which they had been accepted. This year's batch includes three (3) students from African countries, Djibouti, Somalia, and Gambia, as well as eleven (11) students from Afghanistan.

The Senior International Students Batch 2020-22 organised the event under the guidance of Dr Kaushal Bhatt, the Mentor for Foreign Students at GSMS. Since its start, GSMS has international students; the number is growing every year; for the batch of 2020-22, there are three (3) students from African countries such as Lesotho, Mozambique, and Namibia, as well as two (2) students from Asia, from Afghanistan.



The orientation began at 11 a.m. with the arrival of the new students, who were followed by GSMS faculty members. The event began with a prayer and the GTU anthem song.



Dr Pankajray Patel, Professor and Director of GSMS-GTU, delivered the welcome address. Dr Patel gave a summary of when the institute was founded and how successful it has been since then. He also advised students to take advantage of this admission chance because many wanted to get admitted but only a few were accepted. He also emphasised the success rate of student grooming, where prior students have returned home and gained placement in good firms, and some have their own start-ups that are working well.

Dr Kaushal Bhatt, Associate Professor GSMS, GTU, provided the Freshers with an in-depth

overview of the MBA (International Business) programme. The advantages of taking this course include the anticipated exposures such as final placements, industrial visits, foreign exchange programmes, the Country Study Project, and learning a foreign language, all of which could result in the identification and formation of possible bilateral trade agreements for export or import between India and the countries being studied. He also emphasised the variety of topics to be covered, the content, and significance of attendance.
