Gujarat Technological University has established three Post Graduate School in the Academic Year 2017-18 and launched various Programs. Graduate School of Management Studies (GSMS) has started with M. Phil in Business Management and E-course of Post Graduate diploma in Digital Marketing in the Academic Year 2017-18. Five Management / Business Studies PG research centres viz. Centre for Global Business Studies, Centre for Financial Services, Centre for Marketing Excellence, Centre for Governance Systems and Centre for Business Ethics and CSR of Business Management are also merged with Graduate School of Management Studies. To promote Internationalization in the Higher Education, three study centres viz. Indo-Canadian, Indo-German and Indo-East Asian Study centres were also merged with GSMS. With a view to provide quality education in the field of Global Business, GSMS has started AICTE (All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi) approved MBA (International Business) from the Academic Year 2018-19. With a view to provide support to Student Start-Up and Innovation, GSMS has started AICTE approved MBA (Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Venture Development) from the Academic Year 2019-20. GSMS is one of the four institutes in entire Indian and only department in Western India which got the approval of MBA (IEV) in the Academic Year 2019-20. GSMS also enrols full time International Students (sponsored by ICCR) for its various Programs i.e. Ph. D., MBA (IB), etc. Being a department of GTU, GSMS promotes the research work in the field of business management and facilitate Joint research projects and foreign study programs in Business Management with foreign university partners in Europe.

GTU students develop battery kit for motorbikes

Ahmedabad: Calling it a significant breakthrough in usage of non-conventional source of energy, Gujarat Technological University (GTU) on Monday said that two of its students have developed a new battery-operated kit to run motorbikes at a much cheaper cost. The new technology is developed by Arpit Chauhan and Kartik Atreya, the university announced on Monday.

The development comes at a time when prices of petrol and diesel have hit record highs in the country.

Sources in GTU said that the new kit would use six batteries of lead acid and lithium to run the motorbikes at only 25 paise for travelling up

GTU vice-chancellor Navin Sheth in a statement said that this electric bike kit has been developed by the students who are startups enrolled with their university's graduate school of management studies.

He said that research efforts are on to develop such electric kits to be fitted in autorickshaws, tractors and ultimately cars.

In the petrol-run bikes, the emission of carbon dioxide and sulphur dioxide is 500g per km. As a result. this electric motorbike will be a blessing in disguise in this time when one litre of petrol costs around Rs 100. It will also reduce noise pollution by 10 to 12 decibels, the varsity said in its media statement.
