Graduate School of Management Studies, Gujarat Technological University regularly organizes industrial visit for the GSMS students to give them practical exposure. As a part of this GSMS organized an industrial visit to Adani Mundra Port, Kachchh, Gujarat for final year MBA – IB & IEV students for two days on 28th & 29th December 2022.



ABOUT ADANI MUNDRA PORT

Mundra Port is the largest private port of India located on the north shores of the Gulf of Kutch near Mundra, Kutch district of Gujarat. Formerly it was operated by Mundra Port and Special Economic Zone Limited (MPSEZ) owned by Adani Group which later was expanded into Adani Ports & SEZ Limited (APSEZ) managing several ports.

In 2013-2014, Mundra Port has handled 100 million tonnes of cargo in a year becoming the first Indian port to do so. It also became India's biggest port by cargo handled.

VISIT DAY – 1 (28TH DECEMBER 2022)

The visit to Adani Mundra port started on 28th December 2022 at 5:00 am from Graduate School of Management Studies, GTU campus in two well maintained and comfortable buses. There were total 76 students of MBA final year along with 4 faculty coordinators. There was a halt at Gurukul Dhrangadhra for breakfast. As per scheduled time, both the buses reached to Adani guest house 'Shanti Vihar' where accommodation was provided to all. After lunch, at 3 pm all left for visit to Mundra port.

On day 1, visit to 'Adani Port Operation Centre' was organized where visit guide explained about the operations of the port in a model room.



Next, all visited the Adani Wilmar where students learned about oil refinery and oil packaging. They learned about production of oil from raw material and different

packaging process. Here, students got the information regarding demand, supply, production management and other management concepts.



As a complimentary gift, each student received ready to cook khichdi with from Adani Wilmar with best wishes.

At the end of the day, all returned to Shanti Vihar and had dinner. Then, all visited the 'Shanti Nath' temple situated within the premises of guest house followed by a cultural program in the hall of Shanti Vihar. The first day of the visit ended with lot of fun and knowledge enriching activities.



VISIT DAY – 2 (29TH DECEMBER 2022)

The second day started at 7:00 am with a session on the better health by the guest house rector followed by laughter session for students.



After a breakfast, students departed at 9.30 am to visit the west port which was around 35 km from Shanti-Vihar. There the chief engineer explained the students about the working of belt-conveyer and loading and unloading of coal and other materials.

From there the students moved towards last part of the visit, adani power plant. There executive engineer explained the design and process of electricity generation.



The visit ended at 1:00 pm, then all took lunch at Shanti-Vihar and left for the GSMS. The whole visit was meticulously planned and professionally managed from start to end. The staff and students are thankful to Adani foundation and also to GSMS for organizing the visit.
