The G-20 (Group of Twenty) is an international forum of the world's largest advanced and emerging economies, representing around 80% of the world's GDP and two-thirds of its population. The G-20 meets annually to discuss global economic and financial issues, as well as to promote international cooperation and coordination on a range of issues, including climate change, trade, and development.

The G-20 Quiz was organized by GSMS-GTU as a part of creating an awareness amongst students about G-20 and to increase engagement of HEIs in implementing G-20 based activities to a wider extent. It covered a wide range of questions related to the organization, including its structure, history, objectives and key policies. In total, 69 students in a team of 2-3 participated in the quiz out of which one team consisting of 3 members was declared as a winner. In the quiz, questions related to the agenda and the operative functions as well as the implementation of G-20 nation-wide were asked and all the participants showed a great enthusiasm.
