Graduate School of Management Studies organized hospital visit for the Post Graduate Diploma in Hospital Management students as a part of their curriculum. The visit was planned at Sewa Rural Trust Hospital, Jhagadia on 23rd February 2023, which was accompanied by the faculties of GSMS-GTU.

The visit began on February 23rd, 2023 early in the morning from the GTU campus, Ahmedabad. The HR director of Sewa Rural welcomed the faculty and students. For a brief introduction of Sewa Rural Hospital, a short movie was shown. The HR head provided information about the hospital and outlined the goals and objectives behind establishing SEWA Rural Hospital.

SEWA Rural (Society for Education, Welfare and Action–Rural) is a voluntary development organization involved in health and development activities in rural tribal areas in the Jhagadia block in southern Gujarat since 1980. The activities were initiated by a group of professionals drawn primarily from the health and education field. The organization’s work draws inspiration from the ideals and ideas of Swami Vivekananda and Mahatma Gandhi.

For their contributions to the advancement and development of society, one of the founding trustees, Dr. Lataben Anilbhai Desai, received the coveted Padmashree award, the fourth-highest civilian honor of the Republic of India.

SEWA Rural is 150 beds multispecialty hospital, which offers 24-hours OPD, IPD, and Emergency Services. The hospital's primary goal is to offer the highest level of care in Obstetrics and Gynecology, Neonates & Pediatric, and Ophthalmological care. Each year, the hospital treat 12,000 inpatients and 70,000 outpatients, and on average, they birth 2800 babies and perform 8000 procedures.

The hospital has 25 NICUs, the only ones of their kind. Other facilities include laboratory, X-ray, USG, Pharmacy and a mobile dispensary. They have a blood bank facility & dietary facility for the patients & staff. In house Laundry System, CSSD, Fire System & Generator back up facility.

Moreover, SEWA Rural collaborates with the state government in 600 villages to provide healthcare and community health services, conduct research, and teach locals in vocational fields, particularly tribal members. Every year, up to 200 young people receive training at the Vivekananda Gramin Tekniki Kendra.

This organization has received many awards, including the first-ever Sasakawa Health Prize from the World Health Organization in 1985, the international Mac Arthur Award (USA) in the category of Creative and Effective Institutions in 2007, the Lifetime Service Award from the South Gujarat Chapter of the National HRD Network on June 11, 2022 and many others award by various Institutes & Government.

for all OPD patients. The hospital has set up a separate Gynecology Outpatient department (OPD) for the lady farmers who live 90 kilometers away from the hospital.



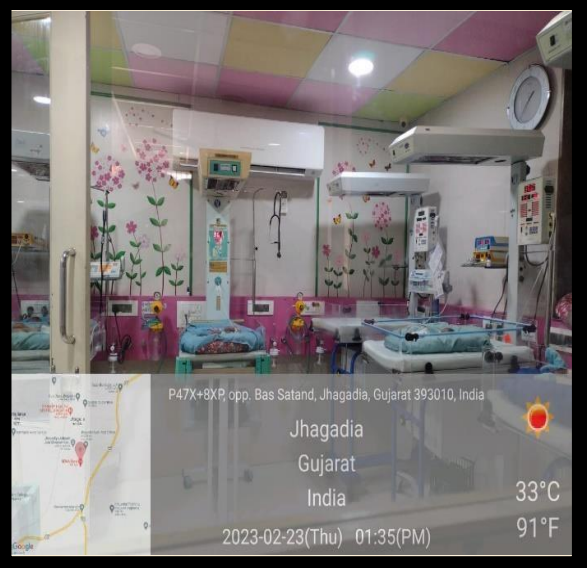
