Date: 12th and 23rd May, 2023



The visit was planned at three Amul plants, one in Gandhinagar on May 12, 2023, and two at Anand on May 23, 2023, and was accompanied by the faculties of GSMS-GTU.

Amul Plant, Gandhinagar



The first visit was planned on May 12, 2023, in the evening from the GTU campus in Ahmedabad. The staff of Amul welcomed the faculty and students. For a brief introduction to Amul and its memorable history, a short movie was shown. Further, students were directed towards the plant, where the process of checking milk quality and converting it into various products was shown and explained.

Each product made in the plant was shown, and the packaging process was described to the students. Also, the quality-checking process was explained to students by the staff. Overall, it was a very nice and informative visit.

Then, on May 23, 2023, another industrial visit was organised by GSMS for the students of BBA at the headquarters of Anand Milk Union Limited, Anand.
