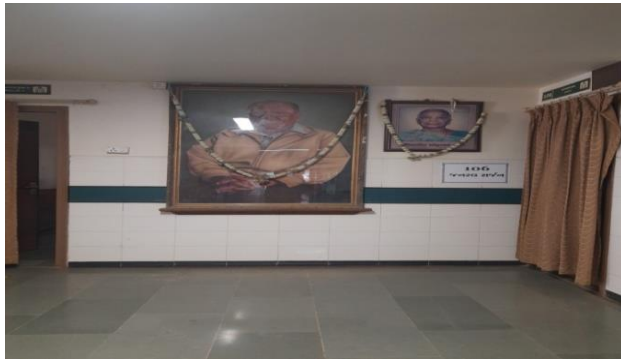
The Hospital and CHC is working on PPP (Public Private Partnership) model in Gujarat. In the History There is only CHC which is run by Government. Aim of the Hospital is to provide free of cost to the needy & best medical treatment free of cost. The Hospital has received **LaQshya** certification to enhance the standard of service in maternity operating rooms and labour rooms in public health facilities.

Shree Chhotubhai A. Patel Hospital & CHC is 150 beds Multi Speciality Hospital with all the Facility under one roof like OPD, IPD, Accident & NICU, PICU, State of the art Operation Theatre, Radiology, Laboratory, Gynecology, Dentistry, Dermatology, Orthopedic department, Special Rooms, Deluxe Room, Semi-Special, General Ward & Post-Mortem facility & Pharmacy.

Hospital has partnerships with three foreign universities for several research projects and 1000-day care for low birth weight babies

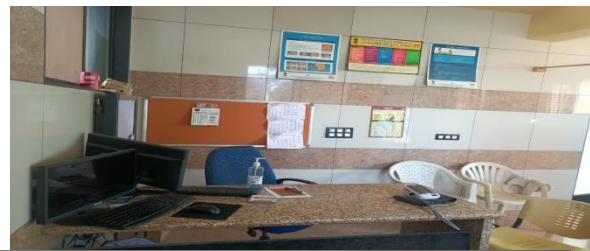
Hospital have a telemedicine van that goes to different villages for free health check-ups, consultations, prevention & treatment etc.

Hospital have created a cutting-edge, paperless system using the technology approach, where all the records are saved on a tablet. Hospital have created software that operates flawlessly. All patient data, including medical histories, lab results, treatment plans, doctor's orders, progress notes, nurses' notes, etc., are recorded and saved in that software. For upcoming use, this information is easily retrievable whenever needed.



### **Out-Patient Department:**

Hospital have separate OPD & Diagnostic facility with sufficient space for treatment & neat & clean waiting area for the patients.



## In-Patient Department:

The hospital has created a number of wards, including General Ward (F/M), Deluxe Rooms, Semi Special Rooms, and Special Rooms, among others. Attractive Pediatrics separate OPD Room has been there for Pediatric patients.
