4) Description of Event

The Yuva Aapda Mitra Disaster Management Training Camp was organized under the National Service Scheme (NSS) by GTU School of Management Studies (GSMS) with the objective of training young volunteers to respond effectively during disaster situations. The Aapda Mitra program has been initiated by the Government to develop a trained volunteer force capable of providing immediate assistance during natural or man-made disasters, especially in situations where professional rescue teams such as SDRF may require time to reach the affected areas.

During the camp, participants were provided with both theoretical knowledge and practical training related to disaster management. Sessions were conducted on different types of disasters and the precautionary measures required to ensure personal safety during emergencies. Training was also given on evacuation techniques and methods to assist affected individuals in moving safely to secure locations during disaster situations.

Overall, the training camp contributed significantly to the development of discipline, teamwork, confidence, leadership qualities, and a strong sense of social responsibility among the participants. The camp successfully prepared trained Aapda Mitra volunteers to serve society effectively during disaster situations.

1. Ikram Singh.

Shri Ikram Singh provided an introductory session at the beginning of the training camp.
