6. Chief Guest: M.D.O.B.C. Cor. P.P. Senghor

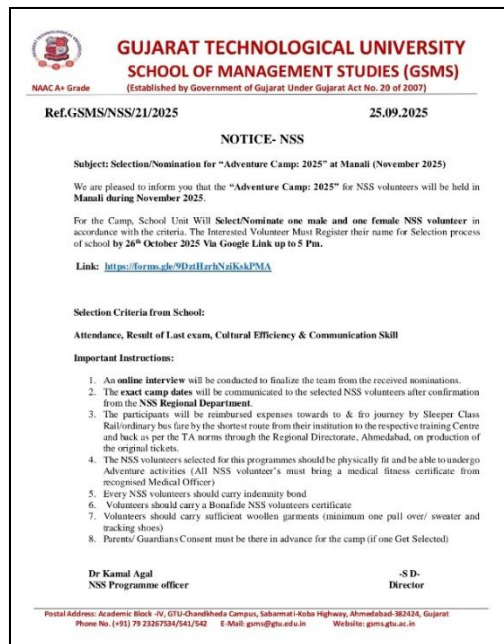
