The Institute appreciates the enthusiastic participation and responsible conduct shown by the students during the blood donation camp.



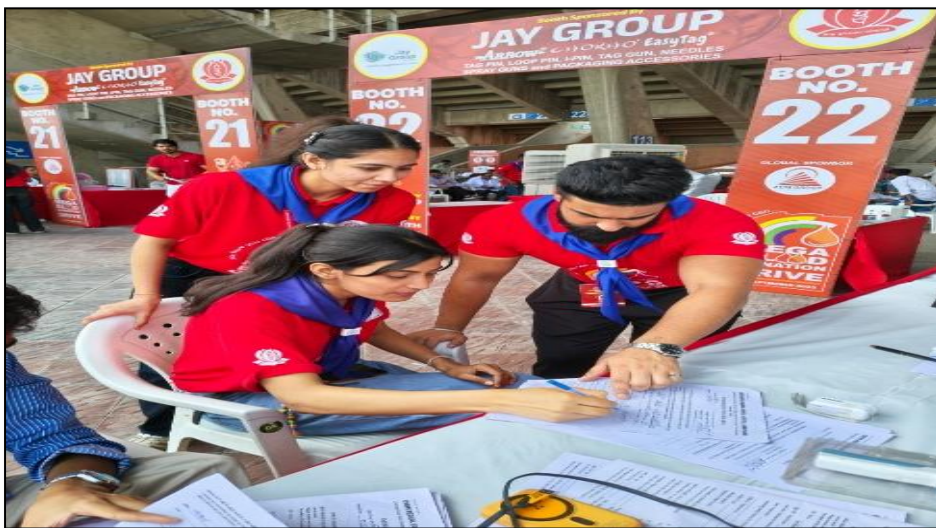
