4. Description of Event:

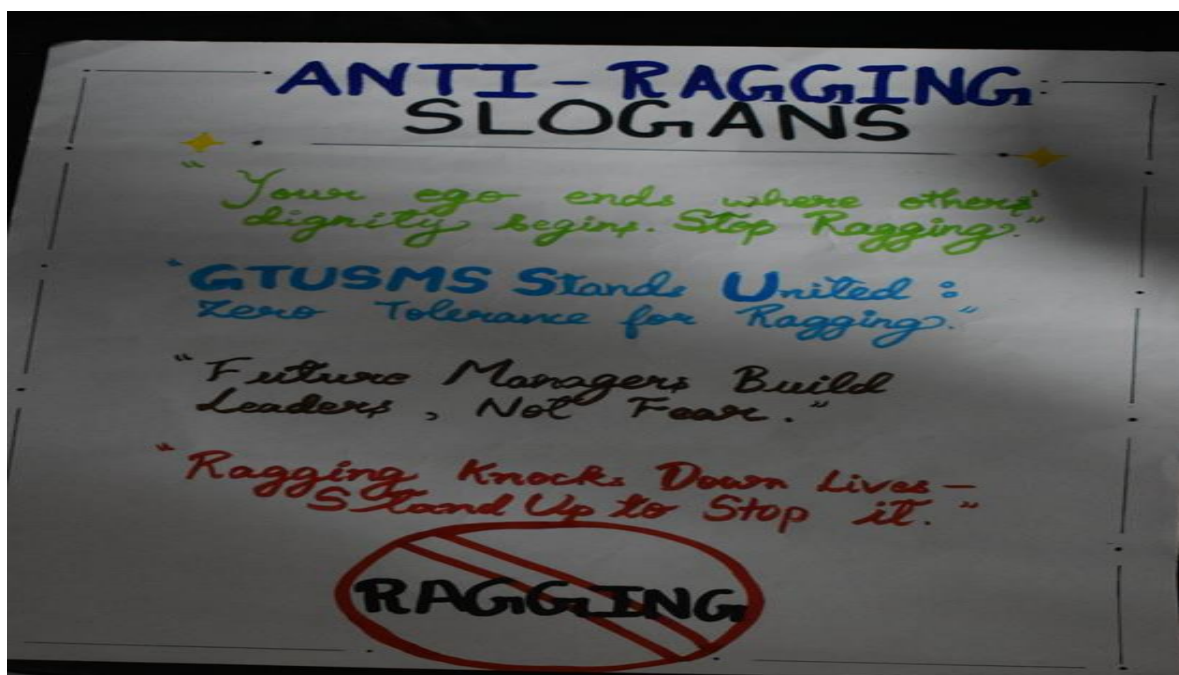
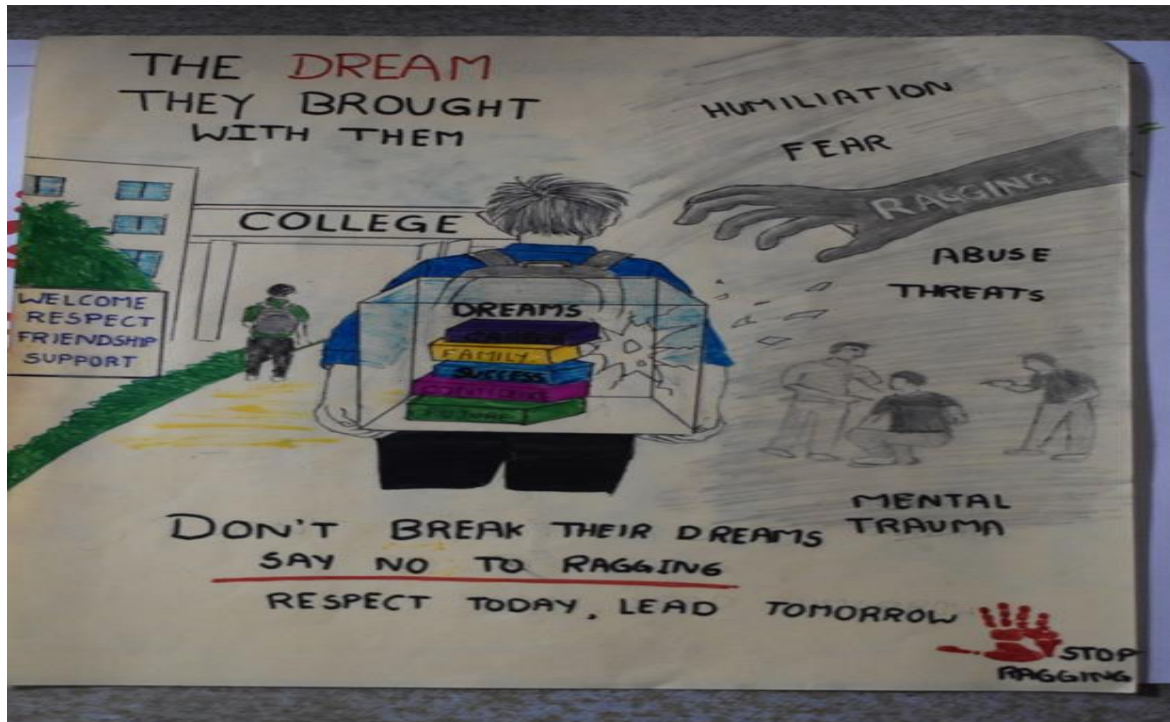
